**DriWater, Inc. Donates Organic "DRiWATER" Grown Fresh Vegetables to Redwood Gospel Mission**

Santa Rosa, CA – August 25, 2008 – DriWater, Inc. is very proud to announce that they are into their sixteenth summer season of donating local fresh "DRiWATER" organically grown vegetables to the Redwood Gospel Mission, located on 6<sup>th</sup> and Wilson Street in Santa Rosa, CA. The vegetables are grown in the gardens at DriWater, Inc., using DRiWATER time-release plant water, natural water bound in the form of a solid gel, as their main constant watering supply.
